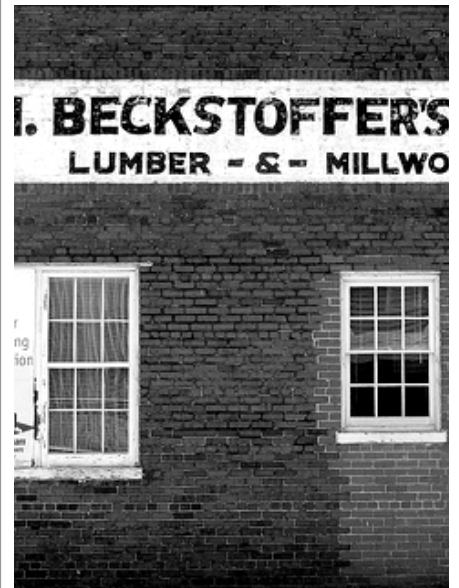
Churches own many vacants on Fairmount Avenue
